Judging criteria for primary

1. Clarity of the message

- a. Is the poster understandable without additional information?
- b. This is the question from which the investigation starts?
- c. Are the results and conclusions clear?

2. Data collection

- a. Is the data collected appropriate for the research? (Some clarification on possible limitations that may arise in the data collection process)
- b. Are the data sources mentioned on the poster?

3. Analysis and conclusions

- a. Is the data analyzed according to the research?
- b. Are there conclusions and are they supported by the data?

4. Graphs and tables

- a. Are graphs/tables/statistics appropriate for displaying and summarizing data?
- b. Are the graphs/tables directed and explained correctly?

5. Presentation

- a. Is there a good balance between graphics and text?

6. Creativity/importance

- a. Is the design creative and original?
